Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL)

1. Check your vaccination status

I have/will have completed my full COVID-19 vaccine regime.

*Individuals will only be considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 two weeks after he or she has received the full regimen of the Pfizer-BioNTech/ Comirnaty or Moderna Vaccines currently administered under the Singapore National Vaccination Programme, or vaccines on the World Health Organisation's Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL). You may refer to https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/health/vtsg for more details.

2. Pre-Application Checks

- Does my vaccination certificate contain digitally acceptable form of QR codes required for submission? https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/vtl/faq#QRcode
- Is my point of departure listed under the VTL countries? https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/vtl/requirements-and-process#countries
- Will I remain in/travel to/transit (excluding air transit) via any VTL (Air) countries/regions and/or Category I countries/regions and/or Singapore in the last 14 consecutive days before arrival in Singapore?

3. Apply

YES to all 3 questions, you are eligible for Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) via Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL).

COVID-19 Tests and Documents Required for VTL

COVID-19 Tests:

Pre-departure:

COVID-19 PCR or professionally administered ART taken within 2 days before departure for Singapore.

On-Arrival Test (OAT):

Vaccinated Travellers entering Singapore are required to report their **unsupervised self-swab ART** test result via sync.gov.sg within 24 hours of arrival in Singapore, before proceeding with their activities in Singapore. Travellers are advised to only purchase and use <u>COVID-19 self-test kits</u> <u>authorised for use in Singapore</u> by the Health Sciences Authority.

Documents Required:

- Accepted proof of vaccination
- Negative Pre-Departure COVID-19 Test
- Valid Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)
- COVID-19 Insurance Policy
- Valid Visa (for visa-required visitors)

Here is the VTL (Air) traveller checklist for the full list of requirements to complete VTL (Air) travel.

Pre-Flight Checklist

- 1. Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) or Approval Letter of Entry (ALE)
- 2. Visa (if required)
- 3. Insurance:
 - Minimum coverage of S\$30,000 for COVID-19-related medical treatment and hospitalisation costs.

4. Flight ticket:

• Do arrive in Singapore at least 12 to 24 hrs hours prior to your first engagement.

5. TraceTogetherApp:

• Download the TraceTogetherapp and register with the same details as per your passport. Visit https://www.tracetogether.gov.sg/for more information.

6. Singapore Arrival Card:

• Submit your declarations at https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard/ up to three days prior to your date of arrival in Singapore.

7. Pre-departure COVID-19 Test at country of departure:

• Take a COVID-19 PCR test 2 days prior to your scheduled departure flight at an authorised medical institution. Please refer to https://www.moh.gov.sg/covid-19/statistics/accreditation-bodies-for-covid-19-testing.

8. Obtain a test result certificate IN ENGLISH stating the following:

Name and passport number/date of birth as per your passport used for entry to Singapore:

- Negative COVID-19 test result
- Time and date when your COVID-19 test was taken
- Name of the testing institution

9. Accepted proof of vaccination:

- On accepted mobile application or vaccination certificate IN ENGLISH.
- Check https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/vtl/travel-checklist for valid proof of vaccination.

Attending The MarTech Summit Singapore – Local Attendees

1. Pre-requisite for Local Attendees

You need to be:

- Fully Vaccinated under Singapore's National Vaccination Programme; <u>OR</u>
- Recovered from COVID-19, i.e. less than 180 days of first positive Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test result obtained in Singapore; <u>OR</u>
- Recovered from COVID-19 in Singapore, i.e. 180 days of first positive PCR test result and subsequently received 1 dose of WHO EUL vaccine in Singapore; <u>OR</u>
- Medically ineligible for all vaccines under the National Vaccination Programme.

Note: Those issued Stay Home Notice or Isolation Order will be denied entry.

2. Registration

- **Summit Attendees**: Bring your Confirmation of Registration email to exchange for your Delegate Pass.
- **Sponsors**: Ensure you have a valid sponsor pass.
- Exhibitors: Ensure you have a valid exhibitor pass.
- Please note that only pre-registered and pre-approved attendees will be allowed in. **So register today!**



Safe Entry into Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre




- Guests' arrival via Level 1 Main Entrance.

- Guests will do a Safe Entry Check-out and leave the property via the Level 1 Main Entrance.









TraceTogether only Safe Entry into Suntec Singapore












Your Health and Safety Is Our Priority

A comprehensive programme of enhanced safety and cleaning standards, designed to create a safe and comfortable venue for you.




Safe Entry

Air quality throughout the centre is enhanced with regular air filter changes, use of UV-C lamps and state-of-the-art air conditioning controls to maintain optimum standards.




Enhanced Cleaning



including frequent washing of hands.




Wear Mask
